Match Discounts: Decided match participants 18 years and younger as well as first time shooters will not pay match fees. No other discounts will be offered.

FT Greely-Long Range: Ron is checking on dates (looking at July 25-26). We will have one Saturday-Sunday weekend match. Saturday will shoot 800, 900, & 1000 yards; Sunday will be 1000 yards three times. On site participants may decide to vary the program on Sunday to shoot out to longer range such as 1100 or 1200 yards.

Matches at BRSP: They are willing to support ARC matches by waiving the \$200 fee and charging individual shooters instead. They would charge members \$20 and nonmembers \$25. We also agreed there would need to be something in it for ARC to cover expenses and make a little money.

JBER RSO – All ARC members should be certified by the NRA or CMP prior to getting their military RSO Certification.

Liability of the Club and Officers: Ron will talk with an attorney (Ralf) about the relative benefits of managing liability through one or more of the following; 1 Insurance, 2 Having a waiver of liability, 3 forming a corporation or LLC.

Bylaws: There are a few minor changes that need to be updated. We also discussed adding two or three match directors to the Board of Directors and formally adding the member at large position.

National Guard High Power Training and Participation: Evidently Brian Felts is running into a number of hurdles. The Guard is willing to provide rifles, ammunition and other equipment for competition, but seems unwilling to cover time and travel expenses. Range Control also has an issue with having military and civilian concurrent use of ranges.
