### NEW Business

Review and vote on proposed Bylaws amendments. Unanimously approved with the following changes: Article V a – clarify that 18 and over can become voting members.

Remove this struck through text: "...for those ~~under the~~ age 20 years or younger."

Article VIII – change "\$15 for non-voting members." to "\$15 for Junior members."

2021 Draft Schedule posted to website – planning 1000yd match in Talkeetna or JBER. Delta Junction would be 3rd choice but would need volunteer match director.
