Directions: Coming from Anchorage, going north towards Wasilla on Alaska Highway 1 (Glenn Highway) at the interchange on the Palmer hay flats you will take Alaska Highway 3 (Parks Highway) towards Wasilla Highway 3 and continue for 59 miles. You will arrive at the USSA shooting range located on right side of the road.

Rules: This is a CMP sanctioned state championship. Current CMP High Power Rifle Competition will govern. Open Bolt Indicator, Hearing and Eye Protection are required (Rule 2.0) It is the competitors responsibility to know current rules governing this match in the CMP high-power rule book.

Eligibility (Rule 3.0): All CMP-sponsored or CMP-sanctioned matches are open to any individual or team that complies with these eligibility requirements. U. S. citizenship is not required to participate. Non-ARC members must pay \$5 one-day membership fee.

Pre-Register: ALL competitors are required to pre-register prior to the match, utilizing the club's website: <https://akrifleclub.com/schedule/>. Walk-on participants may register on a space available, first come, first served basis. **Lunch will be provided after match 2 has been fired by all competitors.**

Fees: State Championship Fee - \$40. Non-ARC members pay \$45. (Shooters under 18 are free but must pay \$5 daily ARC membership fee if not members).

Entries Due: 0900 AM – 0930 AM. Sign in at the rifle range.

Start Time: 1000 AM

Squadding (Rule 6.2.1): Squadding assignment for individual matches will be assigned a day prior to match, walk-ons will be assigned morning of sign in. Competitors may be squadded by Match Officials to ensure that individual competitors or teams of similar ability fire under

relatively equal conditions. Any request for special squadding needs will need to be sent to John Winsor 2 days prior to the match.

Classification: The CMP Long Range Rifle classification system will be used (Rule 4.10.7). Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class (Rule 4.10.9), Competitors who do not have a CMP Classification, but who have an NRA classification, may elect to compete with their current NRA classification (Rule 4.10.8).

Targets: 1000-yard LR (Rule 5.6.2 d) and LR-FC (Rule 5.6.4 b). Shot marker electronic target systems will be used (Rule 7.0). Club provides tablets for shooters and scorers or participants may use their own devices. Ammunition must remain supersonic (minimum of 1200fps residual velocity at 1000yards) to ensure the Shot marker sensor microphones can hear the shot properly to locate it on target.

Firearms: Service rifle (Rule 5.1.1, 5.1.2, 5.1.3, 5.1.4) Long Range Service Rifle (Rule 5.1.6) Match Rifle (Rule 5.1.5) Palma Rifle (Rule 6.9).

F-Class: F-Class Target Rifle (F-TR) (Rule 5.1.7), F-Class Open Rifle (F-O) (Rule 5.1.8)

AR Tactical Rifle (Rule 5.1.9) **F-Class Practical Rifle (F-P) (Rule 5.1.10) (New class 2026)**

**Course of Fire: (Rule 6.9 Table 7- CMP Long- Range match course)**

Match 1: Unlimited sighters and 20 shots for record at 1000 yards., time 30 minutes.

Match 2: Unlimited sighters and 20 shots for record at 1000 yards, time 30 minutes

Match 3: 2 convertible sighters and 15 shots for record at 1000 yards, time 22 minutes

Match 4: 2 convertible sighters and 15 shots for record at 1000 yards, time 22 minutes

Match 5: 2 convertible sighters and 15 shots for record at 1000 yards, time 22 minutes

Match 6: Will consist of an aggregate of matches 1-2-3-4 and 5 above.

Note: F-Class shooters will fire the same course as the Prone Long-Range shooters, only they will use the LRFC target (Rule 5.6.4 b). and will fire either F-TR, F-Open with a Long-Range classification against other F-Class shooters only. **AR Tactical rifle will shoot the LR target (Rule 5.6.2 d). F- Practical the total “current” manufacturer’s suggested retail price of a competitor’s rifles, scope and bipod may not exceed \$3,000.**

Awards: Plaques will be awarded for places 1-3 must be minimum of 5 shooters in each category for awards. There will also be CMP awards. Awards will be distributed at the conclusion of the final match once scores have been recorded in Shot marker.
