FIREARM-22LR rifle

DISTANCE-300 Yards

TARGETS-1 ea 8" gong, 1 ea 6" gong, 1ea 4" gong

POSITION-Seated at bench

SUPPORT EQUIPMENT-Bi-pod, front bag, rear bag allowed. NO one piece devices (lead sled)

SAFETY-All BRSP safety rules apply. Match Director shall give a safety briefing prior to match. BRSP Executive Director or RSO must approve 22LR rifle use on A Range prior to scheduled match or practice.

SIGHT IN PERIOD-Each shooter will have a 5 minute sight in/warm up period prior to shooting for score the first round. Shooter must have a known zero and actual or estimated ballistics at 300 yards

SCORING-8"=1 point, 6"=2 points, 4"= 3 points. Maximum per string-1, 2, 3, 3, 3, 3, 3, 3, 3, 3=27. This assumes all hits are made and the shooter advances targets after each hit. Every shot shall have a score; 0-3.

STRING OF FIRE-10 shots in 3 minutes, time starts at first shot

TOTAL SHOTS PER MATCH-50 shots for score (time may dictate actual)

SQUAD-Shooters will work in squads, a minimum of three; shooter, spotter, scorekeeper/time keeper. Number of members per squad shall be dictated by number of shooters, available equipment, and safe distance between squads at the firing line. (I expect 3 or 4 squads shooting consecutively.)

EXAMPLE COURSE OF FIRE-John Doe is the shooter. First shot is always at the 8" target, if he misses it is scored a zero and he reengages the 8". If he hits (spotter calls hit) the score is one point. At that time John Doe may move to the 6" or remain at the 8" but he must announce this decision. If he moves to the 6" and misses the score is zero and he must move back to the 8". If he hits the 6", the score is two points he can remain on the 6" or move to the 4". If he moves to the 4" and misses, he moves back to the 6". If he hits the 4" the score is three points and he reengages the 4". This continues for 10 shots or the three minutes expires. Squad will then rotate positions and continue. Shooting order for the first string is made with a random number

drawing. Remaining strings shooting order is determined by scores from prior string; lowest scores shoots first.

MATCH PREP-Set up targets at base of A range berm, paint targets, move benches down range to achieve a firing line with 300 yards to targets, set equipment tables and rifle stands near firing line.

BRSP SAFETY BRIEF

Eye and Ear protection is mandatory

Empty Chamber Indicators(ECI) are mandatory at all times when not shooting

Do NOT handle anything thing while shooters are down range (Range is Cold)

Only the Match Director may call the range is HOT

Anyone can call cease fire

While moving firearms, ECI must be inserted with muzzles up, or bagged

Muzzles shall always be pointed down range or vertical while moving a flagged rifle

Emergency procedures, trauma kit locations
