**Rifle Categories: Vintage and Open**

**1. Vintage Rifle as issued. Examples:**

- **Vintage Military Rifle: Wood and Steel Manually Operated such as: Mosin Nagant, Mausers, Springfield, US 1917, Enfield's, Lebel, Krag's, Trapdoors, Swiss, Swedes etc. Iron Sights Rack Grade in production before 1956**
- **Vintage Semi Auto: FN 49, SVT, FNFAL Johnston M1941 etc made before 1956**
- **M1 Garand: as issued**
- **M1 Carbine: as issued**

**2. Open Rifle – Examples**

- **Unlimited Modern Military Rifle - Optics Allowed AR15, M1A, M4, etc. Can Have match grade parts/modifications.**
- **M1 Garand or other vintage with match modifications.**
- **M14/M16 Civilian Equivalent with iron sights as issued.**
- **ComBloc Semi Autos: AK47 clones, SKS**
- **Match Rifle: Any Rifle, Any Sights**
- **Sporting Rifle: Bring out your hunting Rifle. Optics allowed**
- **Rimfire: 10/22, Marlin 60, Ruger American Rimfire, Etc. Optics allowed**

**Match will be conducted concurrently with the above rifles.**

### **Program**

#### **Rules:**

1. Match Director will help you determine your rifle category if you aren't sure.
2. Bipod: No bipods allowed for firing.
3. Bayonets: Please remove or stow bayonets.
4. Uniforms: Period gear: allowed and encouraged.
5. Magazines: Any capacity, magazines will not rest on ground, be used for support, not rest on arm etc. Bring two magazines or stripper clips as required.
6. Slings: Slings may not be used Standing/Offhand. Slings may be used for sighters and Prone.
7. Safe ammunition only (no tracers, incendiary, armor piercing, steel, commie, etc.). Any safe ammunition. Please! Cast bullets are allowed.
8. 30 rounds for record (+ 5 sighting shots).
9. No national match equipment on vintage rifles.
10. Rifle must be safe and have safe triggers.
11. Participants will score and change targets.
12. All participants must wear eye and ear protection.
13. Safety Flags empty chamber indicators will be used.
14. This match satisfies the "high power activity" requirement for rifle purchase(s) from CMP Rifle.
15. Course of fire will be at **100 yards**.
16. Loading:
  - a. Slow fire is loaded single round with the muzzle pointed down range.
  - b. 22 Rifle may load from the magazine, 5 rounds per magazine.
  - c. Rapid fire, rifles are loaded once in position. 2 and 8 or 5 and 5 rounds is the load for rapid fire. Shooters will expend all rounds prior to reloading.
  - d. Sporting Rifle: Rapid 4 rounds in 32 seconds, Fired Twice on command.
17. Gear, shooting coats, shooting mats, gloves, spotting scopes are allowed. A staple and staples are recommended. Bring a pencil or pen please. Dress for weather and bring ear and eye protection.

**Course of fire 100 yards**



<u>Stage</u>	<u>Target</u>	<u>Course of fire</u>	<u>Number of shots</u>
Sighters	SR-1	Sighters, Any Position	5 Shots 5 minutes
1	SR-1	Slow fire, Prone	10 shots 10 Minutes
2	SR-1	Rapid fire, Standing to Prone	10 shots 80 seconds (Moose Gun 4 Shots 32 Seconds)
3	SR-1	Slow fire, Standing	10 Shots 10 minutes

**Entry Fee:** \$20.00 BRSP Members, \$25.00 Non BRSP Members (ammo is **NOT** included). One fee for total match.

**Rules:** [Civilian Marksmanship Program Games and Vintage Military Rifle Match Rules](#) will loosely govern this Match

**Safety: Safety is Paramount.**

All BRSP Range Rules remain in effect.

Eye and Ear Protection is required and will be used.

Safety Flags are required to be in your rifle until directed otherwise. You may remove safety flags as directed during preparation and firing periods.

In Spring and Fall lights will be used on D Range.

Match Director may make any match changes or safety decisions. Decisions are final.

Any one may call a Cease Fire for any reason.

This match is conducted on a cold range. Please safely and securely stow your CCW.
