**Rules:** Current CMP rules will govern.

**Eligibility:** In accordance with CMP rule 2.0  
All CMP-sponsored or CMP-sanctioned matches are open to any individual or team that complies with these eligibility requirements. U. S. citizenship is not required to participate. Individual membership in the CMP or a sponsoring organization is not required to participate. No person who has been convicted of a Federal or State felony or any violation of Section 922 of Title 18, U. S. Code, is eligible to participate in any activity sponsored or sanctioned by the CMP.

CMP Eligibility Affidavit Required Before an individual is permitted to participate in any CMP-sponsored or CMP sanctioned competition, the sponsoring club or the CMP Competitions Department shall have on file an affidavit from that individual certifying that he/she:

- a) Has not been convicted of any Federal or State felony or violation of Section 922 of Title 18 United States Code, and
- b) Is not a member of any organization that advocates the violent overthrow of the United States Government.

Rule 9.2.1 and 9.2.2 apply for non-distinguished military and civilian competitors, respectively

**Open Individual Category:** Competitors may compete "OIC" per Rule 2.10

**Pre-Registration:** For base personnel safety, JBER Public Affairs requires ALL competitors to have a DoD ID, or to be added to the list of planned participants at the beginning of the , or to contact the match director 2 weeks prior to the event to be background checked and added to list of cleared participants. Additionally, participants are required to pre-register beginning 2 weeks prior to the match, utilizing the link on the club's website. [www.akrifleclub.com](http://www.akrifleclub.com) . Walk-on participants cannot be accommodated if they have not met the Public Affairs requirements.

#### Registration Capacity and Fees:

Maximum competitors: 24

Match Fee: ARC members \$20, non members \$25

**Entries Due:0830-0915**, at the Pedneau 200 yd line, day of match.

Please Note: **late entries will be accepted prior to safety brief.**

**Start Times:** Firing commences at **0930 A.M.**

**Squadding:** All matches will be squadded. Squadding assignment for individual matches will be issued during registration. CMP Membership numbers and classification cards, if competitor has them, must be exhibited before squadding tickets are issued. A competitor who fails to present himself at the proper firing point when his relay is called may lose his right to compete in that event.

**Rifles:** CMP Service Rifle-Rule 4.1.1, 4.1.3, 4.1.4 CMP Match Rifle-Rule 4.1.5.

**Ammunition:** Competitors may use any ammunition that is safe to shoot. Remember safety is the responsibility of everyone. None of us wish to endanger ourselves or other competitors on the line.

**Targets:** Shot marker will be used to electronically score targets.

**CMP Cup Match Events:** High-power Rifle Long Course 100 shots. **Rule 6.5**

**Stage 1-** 2 sighting shots and 20 record shots in 22 minutes, standing, slow fire, 200 yards, SR target

**Stage 2-** 2 sighting shots and 2 series of 10 shots in 63 seconds, sitting or kneeling, rapid fire, 200 yards, SR target

**Stage 3-** 2 sighting shots and 2 series of 10 shots in 73 seconds, prone, rapid fire, 300 yards, SR-3 target

**Stage 4-** 2 sighting shots and 20 shots in 22 minutes, prone, slow fire, 600 yards, MR-1 target

**Stage 5-** 2 sighting shots and 20 shots in 22 minutes, prone, slow fire, 600 yards, MR-1 target

**Note 1:** Two minutes will be allowed for 2 sighting shots at each stage.

**Note 2:** No alibis will be allowed for rifle/ammunition malfunction. Bring extra ammunition in the event that we have a range alibi.

**Awards:** There will be CMP awards and club awards.
