BRSP 300yd Precision Tactical Rifle with Electronic Scoring

Summary: This is a fun (no awards or classifications) 20 rounds plus unlimited sighters 1 stage high power

rifle "Mid-Range" match fired at 300yards using Shotmarker electronic targets for scoring.

Modern rifles, service rifles, vintage rifles, hunting or match rifles welcome. As long as the rifle

is safe and ammunition is traveling a minimum of 1200fps at 200yards, that will ensure the

Shotmarker sensor microphones can hear the shot properly to locate it on target. You can fire

Rules: Current NRA High Power rules will govern. Open Bolt Indicator, Hearing and Eye Protection are

required!

Eligibility: Open to all. Non-BRSP members pay an extra \$5 registration fee.

Capacity: Maximum competitors: 32

Fees: Tournament Fee: \$20 for BRSP members, \$25 for non-BRSP members.

Entries Due: Choice of signup for one of two firing groups:

Group 1 check in at clubhouse by 18:00 and arrive on A Range by 18:15 for safety briefing If you sign up for Group 1 and there are open spaces in Group 2, you may be able to fire a second relay of 20 more rounds plus sighters. <u>If you can arrive at 16:30 to help with range setup</u>

that would be much appreciated!

Group 2 check in at clubhouse by 19:30 and arrive on A Range by 19:45 for safety briefing.

Start Times: Shooting will start at 18:30 for Group 1 and 20:00 for Group 2.

Online registration at <u>brspclub.clubautomation.com</u> preferred. Walk on competitors will be squadded in a

first come first served basis by signing up at the BRSP clubhouse.

Squadding: Squadding assignment will be issued at the range after signing in at clubhouse.

Classification The NRA classification system will be not be used for this Fun match.

Rifles: Mid-Range Prone: Service Rifle (Rule 3.1), Any Rifle (Rule 3.2), NRA Match Rifle (Rule 3.3)

Palma Rifle (Rule 3.3.1)

Mid-Range Tactical Rifle: NRA Mid-Range (Prone) Tactical Rifle (AR) (PROVISIONAL – Rule

3.3.3)

F-Class: F-Class Open Rifle (F-O) (Rule 3.4(a)), F-Class Target Rifle (F-TR) (Rule 3.4(b)).

Other: Any safe rifle with ammo over 1200fps at 300yds is fine to bring.

Ammunition: Competitors may use any ammunition that is safe to shoot. Remember safety is the

responsibility of everyone. None of us wish to endanger ourselves or other competitors on the

line.

Remanufactured 5.56 mm match ammunition may be purchased from the Alaska Rifle Club by

contacting the match director.

Scoring: Shotmarker will be used to electronically score targets. Ammunition must be supersonic

(minimum of 1200fps at 300yards) to ensure the Shotmarker sensor microphones can hear the

shot properly to locate it on target.

Sighters: Sighting shots (Rule 9.2), which are allowed in the conditions for each match may be taken and

recorded. Sighting shots may be taken in any position.

Course of Fire Unlimited sighting shots and 20 slow fire shots for record, in 25 minutes. 300 yards,

Prone using sling and AR Tactical rifles will use MR-63 target.

All other positions and rifles using artificial support (bench, prone with rest or bipod) will use

MR-63FC target ring sizes for scoring.

Awards: No awards but results for the match will be posted on the club website, grouped by Rifle

category: Service Rifle, AR Tactical, M1 Garand, Vintage Rifle, Hunting Rifle, Match Rifle, etc
