

**2026 Alaska Rifle Club
NRA Long Range Regional Tournament**

- Capacity:** Maximum competitors: 28
- Dates:** Saturday, July 18th 2026
- Location:** Snowshoe Gun Club, 1000yd Range, Kenai, Alaska
- Directions:** Traveling South on the Seward Highway from Anchorage, you will drive 90.5 miles to the Sterling highway merge right onto the Sterling highway drive 57.2 to miles to Soldotna. Once in Soldotna you turn right on Kenai spur road and travel 6.9 miles then turn right at snowshoe gun club. The address is 40450 Shotgun Dr. Ak 99611. Drive past the Shotgun range drive about a ¼ of mile and the Rifle range will be directly in front of you.

- Rules:** This is an NRA sanctioned regional match. [Current NRA High Power rules](#) and [NRA F-Class Rules](#) will govern. Open Bolt Indicator, Hearing and Eye Protection are required! It is the responsibility of the competitor to know rules for their respective shooting discipline.
- Eligibility:** Open to any ARC member. Non-ARC members must pay \$5 one-day membership fee.
- Pre-Register:** ALL competitors are required to pre-register prior to the match, utilizing the club's website: <https://akrifleclub.com/schedule/>. Walk-on participants may register on a space available, first come, first served basis. Competitors are encouraged to pay match fees online. Refund will be issued if match director is notified day before match. Lunch will be provided after match 2 has been fired by all competitors.
- Fees:** Tournament Fee - \$40. Non-ARC members pay \$45. (Shooters under 18 are free but must pay \$5 daily ARC membership fee if not members).
- Entries Due:** 08:45 AM – 9:15 AM. Sign in at the 1000yd range
- Challenge Fee:** \$3.00 The challenge fee must be paid at the time the challenge is requested.
- Start Times:** 09:30 AM Safety brief 9:45 AM range goes hot.
- Squadding:** Squadding assignment for individual matches will be assigned a day prior to match, walk-ons will be assigned morning of sign in. Competitors may be squadded by Match Officials to ensure that individual competitors or teams of similar ability fire under relatively equal conditions. Any request for special squadding needs will need to be sent to John Winsor 2 days prior to the match.
- Classification:** The NRA LR classification system and NRA F-Class classifications will be used. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Assigned Classification (Rule 19.6), or Temporary Classification (Rule 19.2), may be used.
- Targets:** 1000 yard LR (Prone) and LR-FC (F-Class) targets. Shot marker electronic target systems will be used (Rule 10.17). Club provides tablets for shooters and scorers or participants may use their own devices. Ammunition must remain supersonic (minimum of 1200fps residual velocity at 1000yards) to ensure the Shot marker sensor microphones can hear the shot properly to locate it on target.
- Rifles:** DIVISION BY RIFLE: F-Open, F-TR, Prone/Match Rifle, F-Production (F-P) Rule 3.1(c), F-Class Precision - Any Rifle -(F-Any) Rule 3.1(d). F-Class Limited Rifle (F-Limited) Rule 3.1(e).
- Course of Fire:**
- MATCH 1: 1000 yds. Slow Fire prone, unlimited sighters, 20 shots for record, time limit 30 minutes

- MATCH 2: 1000 yds. Slow Fire prone, unlimited sighters, 20 shots for record, time limit 30 minutes
- MATCH 3: 1000 yds. Slow Fire prone, 2 convertible sighters, 15 shots for record, time limit 22 minutes
- MATCH 4: 1000 yds Slow fire prone, 2 convertible sighters, 15 shots for record, time limit 22 minutes
- MATCH 5: 1000 yds Slow fire prone, 2 convertible sighters, 15 shots for record, time limit 22 minutes
- MATCH 6: Day One aggregate: An aggregate of scores fired in Matches 1, 2 ,3,4 and 5

Note: Prone Long-Range shooters will fire the same course of fire as the F-Class shooters. Prone shooters will use the LR targets. All F-Class shooters will use the LR-FC target. Shooters will need a minimum of 111 rds. of ammunition this total includes record and sighters shots.

Awards: NRA Regional medallions awarded for places 1-3. Must be minimum of 5 shooters in each category for awards. F-Production, Precision, Limited will be combined if need to make 5 shooters. Awards will be distributed at the conclusion of the final match once scores have been recorded in Shot marker.
