

## 2026 Alaska Rifle Club

### NRA Mid-Range Regional Prone/F-Class Tournament

- Capacity:** Maximum competitors: 32
- Dates:** Saturday May 2, 2026
- Location:** Pedneau Range, Joint Base Elmendorf Richardson, Alaska
- Directions:** Traveling North from Anchorage exit the Glenn Highway at JBER-Richardson exit, turn right at top of ramp, immediately turn left at gate onto Frontage Road. Traveling South from the valley exit the Glenn Highway at the JBER-Fort Richardson Arctic Valley exit. Turn left then 2<sup>nd</sup> left at the gate onto the Frontage Road. Traveling North on the Frontage Road, go 2 miles and turn right onto the gravel road at the Small Arms Range Complex sign, turn right at Y and follow the signs to Pedneau Range (first range on left).

- Rules:** This is an NRA sanctioned Regional tournament. [Current NRA High Power rules and NRA F-Class Rules](#) will govern. Open Bolt Indicator, Hearing and Eye Protection are required! It is the responsibility of the competitor to know rules for their respective shooting discipline.
- Eligibility:** Open to any ARC member. Non-ARC members must pay \$5 one-day membership fee.
- Pre-Register:** For base personnel safety, JBER Public Affairs requires ALL competitors to have a DoD ID, or to be added to the list of planned participants at the beginning of the season, or contact the match director two weeks prior to the event to be background checked and added to list of cleared participants. Additionally, participants are required to pre-register beginning 2 weeks prior to the match, utilizing the link on the clubs' website <https://akrifleclub.com/schedule/>. Walk-on participants cannot be accommodated if they have not met the Public Affairs requirements.
- Fees:** Tournament Fee - \$20. Non-ARC members pay \$25. Includes NRA fee of \$9.00/shooter. (Shooters under 18 are free but must pay \$5 daily ARC membership fee if not members).
- Entries Due:** 8:30 – 9:15 AM
- Start Times:** Firing commences. 9:30 AM
- Squadding:** Squadding assignment for individual matches will be issued during registration.
- Classification** The NRA Mid-Range Prone Classifications will apply. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Assigned Classification (Rule 19.6), or Temporary Classification (Rule 19.2), may be used.
- Targets:** 600 yard MR-1 and MR-1FC targets. Shotmarker electronic target systems will be used (Rule 10.17). Club provides tablets for shooters and scorers.
- Rifles:** **Mid-Range Prone:** Service Rifle, Any Rifle, NRA Match Rifle, Palma Rifle  
**Mid-Range Tactical Rifle:** AR Tactical Mid-Range Prone Rifle (AR M&P, AR-Any)  
**F-Class:** F-Class Open Rifle (F-O), F-Class Target Rifle (F-TR), F-Class Production (F-P), F-Class Precision/Any (F-Any), F-Class Limited (F-Limited PROVISIONAL)  
**F-Club:** Rifles using muzzle brakes or otherwise not compliant with NRA F-Class rifle rule. Scores not submitted to NRA and not eligible for regional awards.
- F-Class** F-Class shooters will fire the same course as the HP Mid-Range shooters, only they will use the F-Class targets at each distance and will fire against other F-Class shooters only.
- Course of Fire:**
- Match A:** Two sighting shots and 20 shots for record in 22 minutes prone slow fire at 600 yards.  
**Match B:** Two sighting shots and 20 shots for record in 22 minutes prone slow fire at 600 yards.  
**Match C:** Two sighting shots and 20 shots for record in 22 minutes prone slow fire at 600 yards.  
**Match D:** Will consist of an aggregate of the three matches above.
- Awards:** NRA Regional medallions awarded for places 1-3. Must be minimum of 5 shooters in each category for awards. Awards will be distributed at the conclusion of the final match once scores have been recorded in Shot marker. Results for the match will be posted on the club website, grouped by Rifles: Prone, Tactical Rifle and F-Class.
