# Military Rifle Match Shoot and Scoot After Work Paper and Steel

**Categories are listed below: Expect to see all these rifles on the line. You will shoot within the category you have declared at the beginning of the Match!**

1. **Modern Military Rifle Optics Allowed AR15, M1A, M4, etc Post 1956 Rack Grade No Match modifications please**

2. **Vintage Military Rifle: Wood and Steel Manually Operated**  
Mosin Nagant, Mausers, Springfield, US 1917, Enfield's, Lebel, Krag's, Trapdoors, Swiss, Swedes etc Iron Sights Rack Grade in production before 1956

3. **M1 Garand: Rack grade**

4. **M1 Carbine: Rack Grade**

5. **M1 Garand/M14/M16 Civilian Equivalent MATCH: Unlimited, match modifications allowed**

6. **Match Rifle: Any Rifle, Any Sights**

7. **ComBloc Semi Autos: AK47 clones, SKS**

8. **Semi Auto: FN 49, SVT, FNFAL Johnston M1941 etc made before 1956**

9. **Moose Gun: Yes your moose gun Optics allowed Bring out your hunting Rifle (Magnums limited to Paper please)**

10. **22LR: 10/22 Marlin 60 Ruger American Rimfire Etc Optics allowed**

11. **Plasma Rifle in the 40 W range: no (melts the targets, sorry)**

**Bring what you gots, run what ya brung  
Match will be conducted concurrently with the above rifles.**

## Program

### Rules:

1. "As issued" Vintage military rifles in production prior to 1956. Any country of origin. No optics.
2. Other Military Rifles are Post 1956 production military,
3. Moose Gun, 22 LR will fire Concurrently.
4. Sights: VMR/Garand, Carbine, MATCH, Combloc, Semi irons sights only, Other Rifles: any sights, optics. Bring out your rifle, we will fit you in!
5. Bipod: No bipods allowed for firing.
6. Bayonets: Please remove or stow bayonets.
7. Uniforms: Period gear: allowed and encouraged.
8. Capacity: Any capacity, magazines will not rest on ground, be used for support, not rest on arm etc. Bring two magazines or stripper clips as required.
9. Slings: Slings may not be used Standing/Offhand. Slings may be used for sighters and Prone.
  2. Safe ammunition only (no tracers, incendiary, armor piercing, steel, commie, etc.). Any safe ammunition. Magnums excluded from Steel Please! Cast bullets are allowed. Ammo will be inspected and magnet checked.
  3. 30 rounds for record (+ 5 sighting shots). AND Steel Shoot: 20 more rounds recommended.
  4. No national match equipment on VMR rifles.
  5. Rifle must be safe and have safe triggers.
  6. Participants will score change targets.
  7. All participants must wear eye and ear protection.
  8. Safety Flags will be used.
  9. This match satisfies the "high power activity" requirement for rifle purchase(s) from CMP Rifle.
  10. Course of fire Phase 1 will be at **100 yards**. Phase 2 is a Steel Shoot Off.
  11. Loading:
    12. Slow fire is loaded single round with the muzzle pointed down range.
    13. 22 Rifle may load from the magazine, 5 rounds per magazine.
      - Rapid fire, rifles are loaded once in position. 2 and 8 or 5 and 5 rounds is the load for rapid fire. Shooters will expend all rounds prior to reloading.
      - Moose Gun: Rapid Fire 4 rounds for moose gun fired in 32 seconds, Fired Twice on command.
  14. Gear, shooting coats, shooting mats, gloves, spotting scopes are allowed. A staple and staples are recommended. Bring a pencil or pen please. Dress warmly and prong ear and eye protection.

### Phase 1



<u>Stage</u>	<u>Target</u>	<u>Course of fire</u>	<u>Number of shots</u>
Sighters	SR-1	Sighters, Any Position	5 Shots 5 minutes
1	SR-1	Slow fire, Prone	10 shots 10 Minutes
2	SR-1	Rapid fire, Standing to Prone	10 shots 80 seconds (Moose Gun 4 Shots 32 Seconds)
3	SR-1	Slow fire, Standing	10 Shots 10 minutes

## Phase 2

Offhand Creedmore steel match. Elimination Steel Match.  
One shot on command: hit move up, miss you are out!

**Entry Fee:** \$20.00 Members, \$25.00 Non Members (ammo is **NOT** included). One fee for total match. No refunds or discounts if you do not shoot steel please.

**Rules:** Civilian Marksmanship Program Games and Vintage Military Rifle Match Rules will govern this Match

**Safety: Safety is Paramount.**

**All BRSP Range Rules remain in effect.**

**Eye and Ear Protection is required and will be used.**

**Safety Flags are required to be in your rifle until directed otherwise. You may remove safety flags as directed during preparation and firing periods.**

**Ice Cleats may be required. Dress Warm.  
Sunset at 1839 hrs, we have lights!**

**Lead is bad, practice proper hygiene.**

**Match Director may make any match changes or safety decisions.  
Descisions are final.**

**Any one may call a Cease Fire for any reason.**

**This match is conducted on a cold range.  
Please safely and securely stow your CCW.**
